This group exhibition across both our galleries features the work of 7 artists, all responding to the Four Seasons in distinct and different ways.

From direct representation to more abstract explorations of both the look and feel of the seasons, this group exhibition offers a rich and varied journey through the seasons of the year.

Leo Davey works in watercolour, inspired by the seasonal changes in the local landscape in and around his studio in Minehead; Jessamy Keily (JinKs Art), captures the iconic wildlife as they appear throughout the year around her base of Exmoor in pen and ink; Lucy Large works in both wire sculpture and hand-cut paper to capture moments in time; Gail Mason captures the experience of being in a place and a journey through her amalgamations of real and imagined landscapes; Myrtle Pizzey's intricate linocuts capture the flora and fauna of the changing seasons in the Somerset landscape; painter Rachel Sargent is absorbed by the way light changes and defines landscapes through the year and Liz Somerville creates prints that explore the flow and quirks of the west country landscape through the winter and changing year.
