Private patient unit

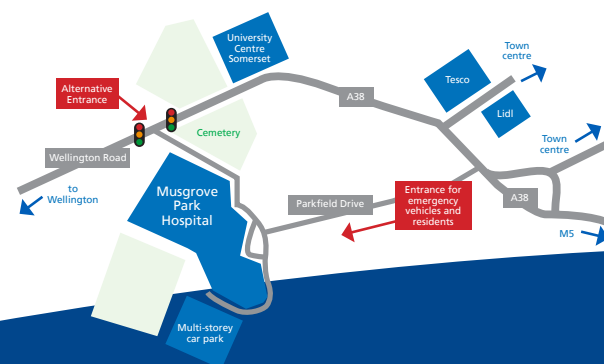
Parkside is the hospital's private healthcare facility. Call 01823 344 141 for information.
